The show attracts a variety of Northfield and Southwood students who possess some form of talents, with acts ranging from singing, dancing, comedy, magic, stunts, variety, and other genres. Each participant who auditions attempts to secure a place in the live episodes by impressing a panel of judges.

Those that make it into the live episodes compete against each other for both the judges' and public's vote in order to reach the live final, where the top three winners receive cash prizes.
