The Indiana State Department of Health requires incoming 12th-grade students to have a second MCV4 (Meningococcal) vaccine prior to their senior year of high school. It is also a new recommendation that all high school students receive the Hepatitis A series. This is a series of 2 vaccines at least 6 months apart. These updates can be made at your physician's office or the health department.
