## **Important Immunization Information**

The Indiana State Department of Health requires incoming 12th-grade students to have a second MCV4 (Meningococcal) vaccine prior to their senior year of high school. It is also a new recommendation that all high school students receive the Hepatitis A series. This is a series of 2 vaccines at least 6 months apart. These updates can be made at your physician's office or the health department. For your convenience, the Wabash County Health Department will be holding open vaccine clinics at the health department in Wabash on the following dates:

June 6 8:00 am – 4:00 pm	July 18 11:00 am – 7:00 pm	August 8 8:00 am – 4:00 pm
June 15 11:00 am – 7:00 pm	July 19 8:00 am – 4:00 pm	August 9 8:00 am – 4:00 pm
June 20 8:00 – 4:00 pm	July 20 8:00 am – 4:00 pm	August 10 11:00 am – 7:00 pm

No appointment is necessary, please bring your insurance card.
